The word in the Hebrew for worship in the verb form is " shachah " and it means " to bow down, to prostrate oneself " or to " lay flat on the ground. " . We see many in the Old Testament prostrate themselves before the Lord. The Greek word for worship that is often used in the New Testament is " proskyne " and this means to " kiss the hand, to fall on the knees, " or to " prostrate oneself " which is similar to what it is in the Old Testament but there are other Greek renditions ...
